Ordered by the Board that the County
of Stark be divided into Townships
of Election Districts as following Viz
Canton Township — (Election to be held at
Cottlers in Canton) Beginning at the South East
Corner of the Ninth Township in the 8th
Range, thence ^{South} with the line between the
Seventh, and Eight Ranges to the South East
Corner of the 10th Township in the said 8th
Range, thence West with the Township
Line to the West Boundary of the Town
Thence South, and East ~~to the Beginning~~
with the County line to the Beginning
Plain Township — Election to be held
George Hartors — Beginning at the North
East Corner of the twelfth Township in
the Eighth Range, thence South to the
South

South East corner of the Eleventh Township
in the 8th Range & thence West with the Township
Line to the West Boundary of the County, thence
South and East with the County line, to the
Place of Beginning -

Nauvohill Township at Henry Lutgenhusen
To include the Eighteenth and
Nineteenth Townships, in the Sixth Range &
the Nineteenth, and twentieth Townships, in the
7th Range -

Osnaburg Township at William Dailas
To include the 17th Township
in the Sixth Range and the 18th Township
in the Seventh Range -

Sandy Township Election to be held at
Isaac Vanmosen - To include the Fifteenth,
and Sixteenth Townships, in the 6th Range
and the Sixteenth, and Seventeenth Townships,
in the 7th Range -

Ordered that the Clerk do ascertain of the
associate Judges of State County how many
Justices of the peace, will be necessary in each
of the Townships in the County, and that
he having got their Certificate do proceed
to advertise an Election in each of the

said Township ~~for~~ to be held on the 1st of
in April next for the number of justices agreed on
the Associate Judges, and for all the other Town
of said Township Officers
