ADMINISTRATOR:

1. The Stormwater Report was given by Dennis Allman, Road Department Foreman, who went over the new policy mandated by the EPA that we letter catch basins. The lettering reads, “Drains to Stream.” Some of the newer catch basins already have this information on them. However, Mr. Allman went over a detailed report. Mrs. Sabina-Campbell said that he has done a fantastic job preparing the report. He said that we will be asking for volunteers who will receive a kit and the brush and the stencil. He is suggesting that the volunteers do this by taking the supplies along in a little wagon. He also suggested that the volunteers be recognized by the press and newspaper for doing this for the Township. Mr. Iacino mentioned that we probably have 5,000 catch basins in the Township. Mrs. Sabina-Campbell pointed out that the EPA was not going to mandate that we do them all, but we did need to show progress. Mr. Leno had a concern with the paint wearing off. Mr. Allman said that certainly it would. It is supposed to last two to three years; however, he had his doubts.
