

**WORK SESSION**

**ATTENDANCE:**

President Giavasis convened the work session at 6:20 p.m. Mr. David Crowder of 1665 Markley Street NW was present to discuss a water issue that he feels was created by Stark Parks in the placement of the bridge for their walking track. Mr. Crowder stated that the water has always flowed north to south at a steady rate. During a recent rainstorm, the water advanced 170 feet further onto his property than it ever has before. The bridge is 5 feet high and about 30 feet long, and then it reduces to 4 feet. Commissioner Bosley had investigated the property and reported to the other two commissioners. Mr. Bosley encouraged the other commissioners to look at the site before voting on any decisions. Mr. Leno stated that he has seen the property and strongly agrees that the water must rise much higher than it used to before it can go over the mound where Stark Parks built the bridge. Brian Ashman, an engineer with Cooper & Associates, was present with Mr. Crowder to discuss the calculations and various impacts to a floodplain as opposed to a floodway. He pointed out that Mr. Ed Stetz is the Floodplain Coordinator for Stark County and does not allow any mounding in a floodplain; however, Stark Parks was able to do this. After detailed discussion, it was decided that Mr. Ashman will meet with the Stark Parks Board and discuss a solution before any potential problems occur. Mr. Crowder stated that he has spent thousands of dollars to obtain all of the necessary permits to make improvements to his property and now he fears that everything may be damaged by flooding, and he thanked the Board for understanding his concern.

1. Noise Ordinance – Mrs. Campbell discussed information she had **shared with Captain Shankle from the Stark County Sheriff's Department**, regarding a noise ordinance for Plain Township. She said that several good points were derived from the conversation, such as who would be cited in a violation: the owner of the property, or the party in violation. Mr. Williams pointed out that usually the property owner receives the citation. Situations including rental properties also came into question. Sergeant Shankle said that many times the citation is issued to the party in violation. He also stated that the ordinance would be very helpful to the deputies. Mr. Williams will work on the noise resolution and add some exclusions; it will be brought back to the Board at the next meeting. A report was given regarding the Edgewood Community Center in the Stonehedge Allotment. Mr. Giavasis stated that he had attended a meeting and it seems that the concerts will cease for the rest of the year; however, on Sundays, the building is used for Sunday services and the strong bass can be heard inside homes. Mr. Leno pointed out that this is an ongoing problem and the Board has been aware of this problem for almost six months.
