President Giavasis convened the work session at 6:20 p.m. Chief Sabo presented to the Board of Trustees the status of the 800 Mhz Radio System in Stark County. The following is a summary of his presentation:

The ultimate goal of those involved in the planning process is to get all government entities operating on the system for true county wide interoperability. This will not happen in the immediate future because of overall financial constraints. It must be done in phases as grant money and other funding sources become available. Tower sites, adequate frequencies and re-banding to the 700 Mhz band are all factors dictating the process for the system development.

The first major step is to combine Canton City's tower sites and frequencies with Stark County's tower sites and frequencies. This will be accomplished with a recent grant of approximately \$3 million which was written by representation of all the county share holders. There will be matching funds needed from the county and city to ensure the receipt of this grant. Chief Sabo encouraged the board to support this within their county association and to support the concept of appointing a committee of the stakeholders to administer the county radio system.

Chief Sabo also explained that there is a distinct difference between the current study being done to evaluation the combination of dispatch centers and the planned improvements to the communications infrastructure. The infrastructure improvement must continue forward because they have no direct association to the study being done. However, with an interoperable county wide communications system coming closer to reality it makes a county wide 911 and central dispatching system make so much more sense.
