Enclosed you will find your unit number. Please place this on your rearview mirror or somewhere visible. Parade check-in time will be from 9:00 a.m. through 10:30 a.m. The Parade will begin promptly at 11:00 a.m. The Parade starts at Edelweiss St., off of Middlebranch Ave., and ends at Middlebranch Ave. and Diamond St. Middlebranch Ave. will be closed to the public and all traffic from Easton St. to Diamond St. except for emergency vehicles only. All Parade Units must enter off of Easton St. onto Middlebranch Ave. and check-in with the Parade Marshall. Your unit will be directed down to Aspen St. which connects around to Edelweiss. Your unit number will be outlined in chalk on the road. Please park and center your unit over the chalked area. The Parade will end and exit through Diamond St.

Trailers and/or extra vehicles that are not in the Parade can be parked in the Diamond Community Park parking lot. No public parking will be allowed in this lot for the festivities following the Parade. Please get to your trailer or extra vehicles in this lot and exit ASAP after the Parade has concluded.

Parade Guidelines, including a map, have been enclosed to further assist you in understanding the Parade Route and the road closures.
