

## The Canton Recycle Center

Canton City Public Health in partnership with the Stark-Tuscarawas-Wayne Recycling District and the City of Canton proudly brings you the Canton Recycle Center - a **“FREE”** drop-off recycling facility, located at 742 Schroyer Ave SW in Canton, serving the citizens of Stark, Tuscarawas and Wayne counties.

The Recycle Center originally opened in 2010 as a tire collection facility to rid city neighborhoods of old tires that posed a public health nuisance. Since that time, the Recycle Center has morphed into a “1 Stop Shop” where tires, e-waste, scrap metals and household hazardous wastes are collected in an effort to protect the environment and reduce the amount of waste sent to the landfills.

Citizens of Stark, Tuscarawas and Wayne counties can drop off up to 12 car or light truck tires (on or off the rim) per person per year. No more than 10 tires can be dropped off at one time without an EPA haulers permit. No semi or agricultural tires are accepted.

Anything that runs off an electric cord or batteries is considered e-waste. The Recycle Center accepts all e-waste EXCEPT Tube TVs and computer monitors. Appliances such as dehumidifiers, air conditioners, freezers and refrigerators are accepted. The refrigerant is reclaimed from these items and recycled.

Citizens can drop off any household hazardous waste, except latex paint, explosives, smoke detectors, DEA regulated materials and bio-medical waste. Some examples of household hazardous waste are batteries, fluorescent light bulbs, fertilizers, pesticides, aerosol cans, oils, gasoline, antifreeze, oil based paints and stains, flammable materials, mercury, acids, bases and chlorine based compounds.

The Recycle Center is open to the public Monday through Friday from 9:00AM – 3:00PM, except for holidays, and the second Saturday of each month from 9:00AM – 3:00PM.
