WHEREAS, upon due investigation and consideration, the Council of the Village of Meyers Lake, Stark County, Ohio has approved a request to Plain Township for the addition of those portions of the Village of Meyers Lake within Plain Township to be incorporated into the Plain Township Fire District. A copy of that Resolution is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference;

WHEREAS, there presently exists a Plain Township Fire District tax levy within the unincorporated areas of Plain Township;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 505.37(C) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Board has determined that there should be submitted to the electors within the Village of Meyers Lake portions which also reside within Plain Township, to add said parcels to the Plain Township Fire District, Plain Township, Stark County, Ohio. A list of those parcels to be added is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein by reference; WHEREAS, upon due investigation and consideration, the Plain Township Board of Trustees, Stark County, Ohio previously determined that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation in and for the Plain Township Fire District, Plain Township, Stark County, Ohio for the tax years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019 will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements for said Plain Township Fire District for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings or sites therefore, or sources of water supply and materials therefore, or the establishment and

maintenance of lines of fire alarm telegraph, or the payment of permanent, part-time or volunteer firemen or firefighting companies to operate the same, including the payment of the firemen employer's contribution required under Section 742.34 of the Revised Code, or to purchase ambulance equipment, or to provide ambulance or emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company for the Plain Township Fire District, Plain Township, Stark County, Ohio and that the question of renewing and increasing the rate of such tax was submitted to and approved by the electors in said Plain Township Fire District; in accordance with Section 5705.191 and 5705.192 of the Revised Code;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.191 and 5705.192 of the Revised Code, the Board had determined that there should be submitted to the electors of the District at the general election to be held November 3, 2015, the question of renewing a tax of six and seven tenth (6.7) mills and increasing the tax by 2 mills to constitute a tax of 8.7 mills outside the ten mill limitation, which amounts to eighty-seven cents (.87¢) for each one hundred dollars (\$100) of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, tax years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019 for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings or sites therefore, sources of water supply and materials therefore, or the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm telegraph, or the payment of permanent, part-time or volunteer firemen or firefighting companies to operate the same, including the payment of the firemen employer's contribution required under Section 742.34 of the Revised Code, or to purchase ambulance equipment, or to provide ambulance or emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company for the Plain Township Fire District, Plain Township, Stark County, Ohio. That submission at the general election held on November 3, 2015 was passed by the electors in the Plain Township Fire District;

WHEREAS, the Village of Meyers Lake, through its council, have requested that its residents located within Meyers Lake and in Plain Township be added to the Plain Township Fire District and this addition if approved by the electors would become effective pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 505.37 on July 1, 2019;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Plain Township Board of Trustees, in their capacity as the Board governing the Plain Township Fire District, Stark County, Ohio that a copy of this resolution shall be certified to the County Auditor of the County of Stark, and this Board hereby requests that the County Auditor certify: (a) the total current tax valuation of the area to be added to the Plain Township Fire District as outlined in Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein by reference, and (b) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the additional parcels as outlined in Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein by reference and located within the Village of Meyers Lake and Plain Township by the rate of 8.7 mills for each \$1.00 of tax valuation;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in compliance with Ohio Revised Code 5705.03(B)(1), the following are all stated: (a) the purpose of the tax will be providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings or sites therefore, or sources of water supply and materials therefore, or the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm telegraph, or the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer firemen or firefighting companies to operate the same, including the payment of the firemen employer's contribution required under Section 742.34 of the Revised Code, or to purchase ambulance equipment, or to provide ambulance or emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company for the Plain Township Fire District, Plain Township, Stark County, Ohio, pursuant to Section 5705.191 and 5705.192 of the Revised Code; (b) this tax is an additional levy upon the parcels outlined in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; (c) this tax is authorized by Ohio Revised Code Section 505.37, also pursuant to Sections 5705.191 and 5705.192 of the Ohio Revised Code; (d) this tax would become effective July 1, 2019; (e) the tax is currently levied upon the Plain Township Fire District; (f) the date of the election at which the question of the tax shall appear on the ballot is November 6, 2018; (g) the ballot measures shall be submitted to the new portion of territory in the Village of Meyers Lake and Plain Township as outlined in Exhibit "B"; (h) the tax year in which the tax will first be levied is tax year 2019, collected in calendar year 2020, beginning and effective July 1, 2019; (i) this tax shall be levied and collected in Stark County, Ohio.

PUBLIC SPEAKS:

- 1. Karl Wagner 1303 Stone Crossing St NE
Mr. Wagner expressed concerns about the closing of the intersection of Easton and Market and the increased traffic shortcutting through the residential area. There is already a safety issue with cars parked on both sides of the streets and pedestrians and cyclists in addition to cars speeding and not stopping at stop signs. Mr. Haws stated that the state and county have control the closing of that intersection. The public absolutely has the right to use these streets whether we like it or not. We can and will request additional sheriff patrols in this area. With respect to the issue of no parking on the streets, the only provisions are if the vehicles are unlicensed and inoperable, weather related or special events. The only exception would be if we cannot get a rescue or fire truck through the street. Any posted no parking signs would apply to everyone including residents. The issue of the Stark Park trail tunnel was discussed in conjunction with the traffic issues. To summarize:1) a speed buggy will be placed in the neighborhood and moved to different positions 2) increased sheriff patrols during the time the intersection is closed 3) will check on the Stark park tunnel project status.

Mr. Mathes wanted to update the board on his property improvements. Mr. Mathes has had a little set back because of medical issues with his mother. He is getting back on track and wanted to inform the board that he is making progress.
