### **Certificate of Conformance**

This is to all property owners and tenants. A Certificate of Conformance Permit is required prior to anyone occupying a building in a Business, Office, or Industrial District.

A NEW permit is required for any change in:

- Business use
- Change of ownership
- Change of tenant

You can pick up an application at the Plain Township Zoning Department at 2600 Easton Street NE.

## **Complaint Procedure**

The Zoning Department receives many nuisance complaints regarding high grass and/or weeds, trash and/or debris, and junk/inoperable/unlicensed vehicles. These complaints will be taken in person, in writing, or by telephone.

Please note that complaints regarding high grass and/ or weeds must meet the following conditions:

- Grass and/or weeds must be over eight inches.
- Grass that is eight inches or taller must cover 50% of the land or more.

### **Zoning Permits Required**

Please contact the Zoning Department to discuss the minimum setbacks and maximum size requirements that apply to your property *before* beginning a new construction project. In addition to a permit application, a site plan drawn to scale of your property is required to illustrate the new construction's size and location on the property. <u>Permits must be issued before the work begins.</u> If you are hiring a contractor, we recommend that you discuss who will be responsible for obtaining permits with your contractor. Remember that the property owner is responsible for compliance of his/her property with all of the Township zoning requirements. ### **Sign Permits**

Almost any temporary sign requires a sign permit, so before you put out that next banner or portable sign, make sure you have obtained your sign permit from the Zoning Department.

A temporary sign permit is good for 30 days. You may put out a temporary sign for two months out of a six-month time period. Please apply for and obtain your Temporary Sign Permit *before* placing it outside of your business.

<u>All permanent signs require permits.</u> Please check with the Zoning Department for size regulations.
